

## SEND questionnaire results 2015 - 16

6 questionnaires were sent out with 4 returned which gives a 67% return rate. All 6 children have been referred to a Paediatrician or EP assessment during the year. 1 child had an EHCP finalised and 2 children are currently going through the EHCP process. All 6 children were on SEN and Early Support Plans with targets reviewed each half term.

### Questions 25% = 1 parent

- 1) I feel that my child is making good progress at school 100% agree
- 2) I know how my child is supported in school 100% agree
- 3) I am concerned that my child is not getting enough support 100% disagree
- 4) I feel that I have sufficient information and communication about my child's progress 100% agree
- 5) I know which stage of the SEN Code of Practice my child is on  
100% agree
- 6) I have had opportunities to share my child's targets with their key worker  
100% agree
- 7) I understand my child's targets  
100% agree
- 8) I am fully aware of how my child is progressing towards their targets  
100% agree
- 9) I feel that Selly Oak Nursery staff have given me suggestions of ways to support my child at home  
100% agree
- 10) I know who the SENCO (Special Educational Needs Co-ordinator) is at Selly Oak Nursery School 100% agree
- 11) I am able to approach the staff about any concerns that I have regarding my child  
100% agree

### **Key comments:**

- I think it is great that so many outside agencies are involved.
- We are pleased that all staff, including the support staff, within Nursery understands my child's needs.
- I have been kept informed of my child's progress by regular meetings and letters.
- All of my concerns about my child have been approached in a sensitive and professional way.

- Link further with the local Children's Centres to further enhance the Family Support links.
