RIGHTS RESPECTING SCHOOL

This policy is in accordance with the 1989 United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC)

Article 5 We must respect the rights and responsibilities of parents and carers to provide guidance to their child as they grow up, so that they fully enjoy their rights.

Article 28 Every child has the right to an education.

Article 29 Education must develop every child's personality, talents and abilities to their full.

Our School:

- School will contact and share information with professional agencies if there are safeguarding concerns regarding your child.
- Aims to achieve a happy and safe learning environment in which all children can develop a sense of belonging.
- Encourages children to work to the best of their ability at all times and to take pride in their achievements.
- Encourages the development of self-confidence and self-worth in each individual.
- Provides a broad and balanced curriculum, which ensures equal opportunity for all children.
- Encourages children to take responsibility for their behaviour both individually and collectively, through the positive promotion of our school rules, sanctions and rewards.
- Communicates regularly with Parents/Carers about what teachers aim to teach each week.
- Informs Parents/Carers of their child's progress and future targets for each half term
- Informs Parents/Carers of their child's progress at a termly consultation evening.

We ask that Parents/Carers support the school in its endeavours to educate their child.

- I will support school in following national, local and school policy and procedures with regard to safeguarding children.
- I will ensure my child arrives at school on time
- I will ensure that my child attends school regularly, avoiding absence (other than for illness or medical appointment).
- I will not take holidays in school term time.
- I will reinforce the school's behaviour expectations with my child at home.
- I will support my child's learning at home.
