Farm visits

The highlight of this term, for many of the children has been a visit to Ash End Farm trip to see the living eggs project. The children took part in a Nursery Rhyme tour, feeding a selection of animals and singing Nursery Rhymes. When the children came back they discussed their experiences, looked at the photographs, drew pictures and wrote a little about what they had seen. The children will use their knowledge for the Living Eggs project over the next 2 weeks when the incubator and eggs arrive!

This term the Curriculum team have focused on revising number development and number skills at the nursery as they evaluate the impact of children's learning with the introduction of the maths shed.
