This year the Governors have aimed to communicate better with parents about our role, we have had a particular focus on balancing our school budget, and ensuring Selly Oak Nursery has sufficient teaching staff.

Members of the Curriculum team have regularly visited the school during the school day, during school trips and forest school to see how the children are developed through the creative school activities that staff use.

Members of the finance committee are delighted to report that the schools financial picture is more secure. We have also started budgeting not just for 1 year but over 5 years to help us highlight potential financial problems well before they happen. We are also delighted that despite ongoing funding pressures we have been able to appoint a new teacher to replace Miss Dovey.

The Premises Committee were delighted to oversee the first phase of a refurbishment of the buildings; creating more space for children to make art. The refurbishment also included some better facilities for nursery children, like low sinks. We also have a further plan to develop Nursery buildings.
