

SEN questionnaire results 2014 - 15

8 questionnaires were sent out with 5 returned which gives a 62.5% return rate. All 8 children have been referred to a Paediatrician or EP assessment during the year. 4 were on SEN and Early Support Plans. 1 had requested an EHCP.

Questions 20% = 1 parent

- 1) I feel that my child is making good progress at school 100% agree
- 2) I know how my child is supported in school 100% agree
- 3) I am concerned that my child is not getting enough support 100% disagree
- 4) I feel that I have sufficient information and communication about my child's progress 100% agree
- 5) I know which stage of the SEN Code of Practice my child is on
40% agree / 40 don't know / 20% didn't answer
(1 parent said she still felt hazy about it but was happy it was in hand by staff)
- 6) I have had opportunities to share my child's targets with their key worker
100% agree
- 7) I understand my child's targets
100% agree
- 8) I am fully aware of how my child is progressing towards their targets
100% agree
- 9) I feel that Selly Oak Nursery staff have given me suggestions of ways to support my child at home
100% agree
- 10) I know who the SENCO (Special Educational Needs Co-ordinator) is at Selly Oak Nursery School 60% agree / 20% partly agree / 20% didn't answer
- 11) I am able to approach the staff about any concerns that I have regarding my child
100% agree

Key comments:

- I am proud of Selly Oak Nursery because they provide a good education and my child has progressed well, thank you.
- Thanks for everything that SONS has done to support and develop my child to prepare them for Reception...they are ready for it now.

Next steps

- Ensure that all parents understand which stage of the Code of Practice their child is on especially if they have an SEN and Early Support Plan.
- Ensure that all parents clearly understand the role of the SENCO and how they will support / advise the key worker.
